Altarum Institute is a non-profit health systems research and consulting organization headquartered in Ann Arbor, MI. While the company is headquartered in Michigan, Altarum Institute also operates through multiple remote offices spread across the country with locations in Texas, California, Washington D.C., Maine, Georgia and more. Both the headquarters and remote offices typically need to back up 1 to 1.5 terabytes of process, health research and health project information.

The Challenge

With a widespread network of remote offices throughout the U.S., managing and securing each of the locations' data was a complicated and challenging task. Kenny Moore, Altarum's IT Specialist, had originally been using Symantec to back up the offices' data. However, the lengthy backup time, unreliability and added cost of shipping physical backup tapes to a secure off-site location proved to be insufficient in meeting Moore's backup needs. Eventually, this escalating cost, in addition to declining support from Symantec, became too cumbersome to maintain.

The Solution

In the process of researching alternate backup solutions, Moore was introduced to Unitrends by a local vendor and decided to adopt it for all of Altarum's offices. Now Altarum uses one location to store the backups of another, so there is no need for remote tape libraries.
